[.id]BANDUNG, Oktober 2016: Bio Farma, dipercaya menjadi tuan rumah *workshop* produksi vaksin bagi negara Islam di Bandung pada 15-18 November.

Workshop ini akan diikuti oleh peserta dari negara Organisasi Kerja Sama Islam (OKI) yang telah memiliki industri vaksin serta negara yang sedang mempersiapkan diri untuk membuat vaksin di negaranya.

Saat ini lebih dari 10 negara sudah menyatakan hadir yaitu Pakistan, Turki, Tunisia, Malaysia, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Maroko, Senegal, Mesir, Bangladesh, serta tiga lembaga dunia yaitu Badan Kesehatan dunia (WHO), UNICEF dan *Islamic Development Bank* (IDB).

Corporate Secretary Bio Farma, M. Rahman Rustan mengatakan Indonesia mendapatkan kesempatan istimewa menjadi tuan rumah ini merujuk pada hasil rapat pertemuan OKI, Konjen RI di Jeddah dan Bio Farma pada tanggal 1 September 2016.

Menurut Rahman, Bio Farma akan mempersiapkan diri sebaik-baiknya untuk mensukseskan program pelatihan vaksin yang berlangsung pada 15-18 November, sebelumnya juga akan dilaksanakan pertemuan terbatas kelompok produsen vaksin negara Islam (*Vaccine Manufacturers Group*) pada 14-15 November 2016.

Rahman menambahkan untuk menyukseskan acara itu perusahaan juga bersinergi dengan berbagai pihak.

Sebagai narasumber akan dihadirkan perwakilan dari Direktorat Jenderal Pencegahan dan Pengendalian Penyakit Kementerian Kesehatan (Ditjen P2P Kemenkes, Badan Pengawasan Obat dan Makanan (BPOM), *The Indonesian Technical Advisory Group on Immunization* (ITAGI), World Health

“Pelatihan produksi vaksin ini juga akan mendiskusikan tentang bagaimana memproduksi vaksin yang aman dan berkualitas,” ucap Rahman.

Sejumlah sesi akan dibahas terkait isu kemandirian. Selain itu, pada akhir acara akan dilakukan *field*

visit untuk memperkenalkan potensi Indonesia dengan keanekaragaman hayati, kekayaan budaya serta potensi pariwisata.

program pelatihan ini sejalan dengan program Nawacita nomor enam yaitu meningkatkan produktivitas dan daya saing di pasar Internasional.

Dengan itu industri vaksin Indonesia mampu dipasarkan secara massif di dunia sekaligus mendorong kemajuan negara-negara Islam.

"Pada akhirnya, *workshop* ini diharapkan menghasilkan pemikiran-pemikiran dalam mentransformasikan dan kemandirian negara Islam dalam memproduksi vaksin,"

Dia mengatakan Indonesia perlu mensosialisasikan keberhasilan dan berbagi dengan negara Asia khususnya negara Islam untuk mendorong kepercayaan negara Islam.

This workshop will be attended by participants from Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) member countries, which have had the vaccine industry and partnering countries who are preparing to make a vaccine for their nations.

Currently there are more than 10 countries who have already declared their presence, which include Pakistan, Turkey, Tunisia, Malaysia, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Morocco, Senegal, Egypt, Bangladesh, as well as three world institutions, namely the World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF and the Islamic Development Bank (IDB).

In addition, at the end of the event will be conducted field visits to introduce the potential of Indonesia biodiversity, cultural and Indonesia tourism. This training program is in line with the number six Nawacita program, which aims to improve productivity and competitiveness in the international market. Therefore Indonesia's vaccine industry are able to be marketed massively around the world and also promote the progress of Islamic countries. "In the end, this workshop is expected to generate ideas for transforming and building self-reliance of Islamic countries in producing the vaccine." He said Indonesia needs to socialize and share the success with Asian countries, especially Islamic countries to encourage the Islamic Countries trust. "Because Indonesia through Bio Farma is given the responsibility as a center of excellence in the field of green vaccines," he said.
